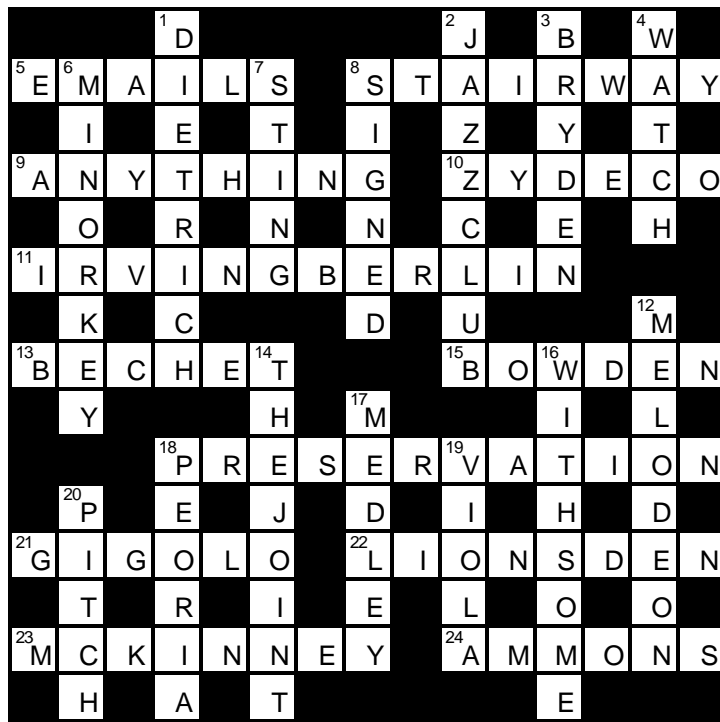

**FT.** Apologies for the smaller edition of the FT. but I had to get something out for our members not on the internet, before it's too late.

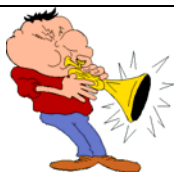
